LET'S GET STARTED!

- Dust mask
- Goggles
- Nitrile gloves (optional)
- Small spritzer bottle (for alcohol)
- Soft bristle brush to remove glass dust
- Rotary tool/drill speeds between 20–40k rpms with flexible shaft (hand piece) and drill stand
- Wrist rest (paper towel roll will do in a pinch)
- Dark glass empty green or brown wine bottles (empty sauce jars or dollar store barware not recommended)
- Tombow Fudenosuke Brush Pen
- Sharpie Peel-Away Wax Pencil (white)
